In a recent tropical storm, the villages along the North coast were all flooded up to two feet deep in some of the homes; a lot of rain in a short period of time made the roads impassible for weeks. One brother sent us a video of the muddy road where the milk tanker semi truck was stuck, and no one passing. I do not know how long it took them to get out!

Please continue to pray for Bro. Lisandro's health, he goes days without being able to sleep. He has a son who is a doctor in Rio Esteban and he with others cannot find the right combination of meds that will give him the proper rest. We sent him a love offering from the Honduras Fund to help with the medical cost of the MRI and other tests he has had. All three of the pastors blessed with your financial help have told me to tell you all thanks so, so very much! They have sent short letters to the churches which we will send on to you as well.
