fter lots of planning, prayer and hard work, we are excited for y'all to know that the Encounter Baptist Church (Iglesia Bautista el Encuentro) of Versailles has opened her doors.

This has not been a very easy path for us. Not only having come to a decision to leave Peru behind, for now, but then coming to the decision to stay in the state of Kentucky has presented it's difficulties. Even until this day, we are faced with opposition from American brethren about our ministry. We have been questioned about where we do ministry, to whom we are ministering and how we operate in the ministry. We have never really experienced this much in the past 20 years while in Peru, but we are learning that home mission work is definitely different than foreign mission work and many people oppose things that they have never done or have never seen done before.

Our home church, Faith Baptist Church, has allowed us to use a space in what was once their sanctuary and then ladies Sunday School classroom. We were able to remodel it some and make it accommodating as a temporary space for a new Spanish-speaking church. We are eternally grateful for this accommodation and for the expenditures made by Faith Baptist Church, which has made the space inviting and special.

Once our space was ready, we knew it was time to fill that space. As many missionaries will share, the normal attendance for a new work consists of the missionary and his family. We were ready and content with knowing that, but had been asking God if he would give us people to minister to. The first service we had a total attendance of 8. The second service our total was 15 and the third service was 17. We are so excited to see what God is already doing. We have also started having Wednesday night prayer meeting. How blessed we are to know that God would see fit to give us people to show the love of Christ to! We are praying that the work continues to grow, that souls would be saved, that lives would be changed and that we could be a light in the Spanish-speaking community.

Please continue to pray for us as the Lord uses us here in Versailles!
