Rev 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

As this world moves into the last stages of wickedness before the end of all things, the people of God watch the decay and dissolution of mankind under the influence of the devil and they are vexed from day to day with the wicked deeds of people gone mad with the freedom of unrestrained rebellion against God. Believers see the promotion of wickedness on every hand, and there seems to be no voice lifted against it which can stand. The powers that be are just now engaged in destroying the witness, the reputation, and the veracity of anyone who stands up and says, "this is wrong!" As never before in the history of man, we have come to the age when the whole spirit of mankind seems to be bent on calling evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter.

In this environment, we as God's people long for these things to be made right. We long to see the insanity of wickedness and perversion brought to a halt. But, folks, that will never happen as long as men lead men, and as long as governments are occupied by men of corrupt and faulty minds. The very combination of having power and having a depraved nature ruling almost certainly guarantees flawed decision making, selfish agendas, and abusive use of those powers. It also guarantees that people living under such godlessness will be made bold to throw off every pretension that they are governed or guided by rules made by the Lord. But all this is about to end, and if you feel like I do, you can't wait for it to happen.

So, we look and wait anxiously for the coming of King Jesus! We know it will be glorious event. But, for those of us who labor at the end of God's day, it may be more glorious than for any other generation since Noah and his family. Because, we see vileness and wickedness being raised to never-before-seen levels by wicked men who have truly waxed worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived.

What I want us to think about today, and what I pray the Holy Spirit will guide us in, is why do we in this generation of spiritual bankruptcy want Jesus to come so much?

I. Because it will put an end to mankind's mockery of God, His power, and His authority over creation

- Men mocking divine creation

- Men mocking the worship of the one true God
- Men denying the existence of the one true God
- Men denying God a place in American society
- Our own countrymen devising and abetting ways to persecute Christians
- It will be the end of the saints of God having their spirits vexed, their faith mocked and themselves persecuted by national leaders and brazen hedonists in this society
 - ▶ **Rev 6:9** And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:
 - ▶ **Rev 6:10** And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
 - ▶ **2Pet 2:9** The Lord knoweth how to ...reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:

II. Because it will be the end of this godless headlong rush of humanity toward judgment and wrath that we see

- ▶ The world and the leaders of our nation seem bent on approving everything that is twisted, perverted, despicable and that ensures destruction at the hand Almighty God
- ▶ We are tired of paying our taxes into a government that is supposed to be the servant of the people only to watch it being spent by them to kill our unborn innocents (how much more condemnation can a nation get than to become a nation that kills its own innocents?)
- ▶ Even so, come Lord Jesus!
- ▶ We are tired of paying our taxes to a government to pay politicians to represent us in Washington D.C., only to have them turn traitor to the people who elected them (one of the greatest condemnations God passed on rebellious Israel was the fact that their national leaders made merchandise of the people)
- ▶ Even so, come Lord Jesus!
- ▶ We are tired of paying taxes to a government that houses officials and leaders who are sitting up nights trying to figure out how to overthrow our culture and way of life – how to usher in an infidel religion into America that denies the divinity of Christ
 - (Do you folks know that 40% of the illegal immigrants who will be given amnesty are NOT Hispanics? But a huge number of that 40% are Muslims? Do you know that this administration has been busy rushing huge numbers of Muslims into the U.S. under all kinds of visitor programs which we pay for? Do you think this is some kind of humanitarian effort to bring cultures together?)
- ▶ Even so, come Lord Jesus!
- ▶ We are tired of supporting a government and our political servants who think nothing of spitting in the face of King Jesus by forcing us to accept perversion and lying as an approved and moral way of life.
- ▶ Even so, come Lord Jesus!

- ▶ We are tired of governments across this nation collaborating with godless, perverted educators in a colossal scheme to brainwash our children into believing that parents are morons (because they believe in Creationism), that parents are narrow minded (because they believe only in heterosexual marriage and that homosexual acts are in defiance of the very foundations of God's purposes for humans), that this country is evil and its founders were evil, and its current conservative population is evil
- ▶ Even so, come Lord Jesus!

III. Because it will usher in government by King Jesus

- ▶ He's coming with power - **Rev 1:7** Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they *also* which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.
- ▶ **Dan 7:13** I saw in the night visions, and, behold, *one* like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven

- ▶ There won't be one liar or murderer in the Kingdom of God when the final judgment occurs
 - **Rev. 21:8** But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.
